



ERPC elects Ulrich Höke as new chairman

INGEDE's Chairman Ulrich Höke will also head the ERPC (European Recovered Paper Council) for the next two years. At ERPC's autumn meeting on 09 September, the attending delegates of the 14 stakeholder organisations elected Ulrich Höke unanimously. CEPI's Recycling Director Jori Ringman-Beck, who also acts as secretary of the ERPC, thanked the past Chairman Phil Mogel of ETS (European Tissue Symposium) for his work in the last two years.

The most prominent task ahead is the revision of the European Declaration on Paper Recycling which has to be

finalized by summer 2011. Ideas for the new Declaration, which will be valid from 2011 to 2015, are to put more emphasis on the qualitative recycling and recyclability targets. Input from INGEDE members is welcome. The Technical Committee (TC) of the ERPC, which had been initiated by INGEDE in the course of the Deinking Scorecard development process, will do the drafting work. For this purpose it is planned that the participants of the TC will join two times additionally before the next regular discussion in connection with the spring 2011 meeting of the ERPC. INGEDE presented the draft for the scorecard to assess the removability of adhesive applications. This document was developed based on the

results of INGEDE Project 129 09 in which we got financial contribution from bvdM, FEICA and FINAT. Representatives of FEICA (association of adhesives and sealants manufacturers) and FINAT (association of the self-adhesive labelling industry) had been actively involved in the preparation of the draft scorecard. The ERPC agreed to its concept as well as to the specifications; there is only some editorial work left to do. It is planned to adopt the final version by ballot later this year.

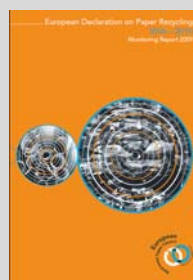

Meeting of the Working Group DIP Quality Management at SCA Hygiene Products in Mainz-Kostheim

From 7 to 8 September the working group met in Mainz-Kostheim by invitation of SCA Hygiene Products. The hosts Markus Klenk and Anne-Katrin Klar presented an overview on 125 years history of paper manufacturing. Especially the challenges of a hygiene paper production made from 100% recovered paper were outlined.

The topics of one and a half day's workshop were:

1. INGEDE database – a commitment on a new survey structure and content was discussed and agreed upon. The redesigned database will start with the beginning of next year.

2. DIP line complexity

The group had a discussion on the established line design and named the positive and negative aspects of different possible equipment.

3. Lobby work/external relations – In this context the ERPC activity on the end-of-waste topic and the proposal for renewing the recovered paper terminology was talked about.

4. Mill presentation – Tuomas Turkama gave a presentation of Utzenstorf Papier located in Switzerland.

5. INGEDE projects – Andreas Faul presented the newly developed assessment scheme for adhesive applications resp. scorecard which is about to be adopted by the ERPC see also page 1.
