In 2010 Van Houtum was officially recognized as a Cradle to Cradle organization.

Magical Annual Production of 90.000 tons at SCA Hygiene Products, Ortmann

On the 30th of December 2010 at ten minutes past seven in the morning PM4 Ortmann reached a magical annual production of 90.000 tons. In our opinion the world production record holder for a Dry Crepe Machine. This achievement is even more remarkable as the superwide 7 meter

unit built by Beloit Walmsley in 1992 was originally designed to produce 77000 tons per annum with a nominal basis weight of 21,5g/m². In 2010 the average basis weight was 18g/m². Having a clear goal fully supported by all the hardworking disciplined teams from raw material planning through to

production management was key to the success.

Referring to the SCA key value sustainability, PM4 manufactured each ton from 100% recovered paper.
