

## INGEDE welcomes Kübler & Niethammer as a new member!



Founded in 1856 by Fritz Kübler and Albert Niethammer, the paper mill made its way through a lively history. From the very beginning the company took care of its employees and was also socially engaged in the community Kriebstein.

The main office and production sites is located in Kriebstein, below the castle Kriebstein in a beautiful valley in Sachsen (Germany). With around 115 employees Kübler & Niethammer generates an annual turnover of 55 million Euro. Its products are made of 100%

Recovered Paper. Under the trade name Kriebcoat, Kübler & Niethammer produces high quality heatset paper from 51 - 90 g/m<sup>2</sup>. A speciality is the production of coldset paper in the same grammage. Kriebcoat is certified with the German environmental label „Blue Angel“. Furthermore the company is entitled to bear the FSC (Forest Stewardship Council) recycled label, PEFC certification (Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification Schemes) is in progress.

## Flexo Round Table “Gruppo di lavoro riciclabilità stampa flessografica” met in Milano

On 15 Dec 2011 the major Italian flexo printer, INGEDE and Burgo representants as well as three representants of ink producers met in Milano for the Flexo Round Table. The discussion dealt with the recyclability of flexo prints and how the paper chain could find a way to achieve a cost reduction for deinking mills and on the other side

advantages for printers and the whole paper chain. These could be environmental benefits and a better environmental performance. The participants agreed to have a close look at the cost impact of changing the inks and will meet again in spring 2012.
