

INGEDE - Annual Events in February 2012 in Munich



The INGEDE annual meetings took place from 8 to 9 Feb 2012 in Munich. This time the Symposium was held on the first day. On the 21st Symposium, the INGEDE chairman Ulrich Höke had the pleasure to welcome 72 participants. First, Ulrich Höke updated the audience on INGEDEs' activities. Ulrich Leberle (CEPI) followed with the presentation "Contributing to the EU resource efficiency roadmap". Johannes Kappen from PTS took up the topic mineral oil and showed an assessment of available options in reducing mineral oil in food packaging and their impact on paper recycling. The questions following this paper showed that this topic still holds discussion potential. The last session in the morning was given by Axel Fischer on INGEDEs' activities in Digital Printing. After lunch Peter Engert informed about the research activities of INGEDE. Presentations on various INGEDE research projects were given by researchers of TU Dresden, PTS, PMV and CTP. Then Siegfried Kreibe from Bifa gave an interesting presentation on

a project to find mid- and long-term chances and risks for the eco-efficiency of paper products. He presented effective socio-scientific tools as a working method for expert groups. Results of this project will be presented at the next Symposium.
