Promoting research and giving a boost to innovations & new ideas is one of the core topics since the 25 years existence of INGEDE. As we could see it now from CEPI's Two Team Project, bundling your forces/power/energy/heads/potentials and the concentrated work towards your goals is the way to be successful/generate achievements. INGEDE regards itself as the strong bundling of its members in order to follow the goals of recyclability and deinkability of paper products and

raise the European political awareness. INGEDE's achievements of the last decades are the remarkable outcome of a joint effort and a hard work. The presented concepts should be of interest for the deinking industry for both sides, raw materials and paper making process. The winner concept "Deep Eutectic Solvents" makes it conceivable to deink in a totally new way and even recover cellulose from rejects. Supercritical carbon dioxide is



a concept capable to remove contaminations. The other concepts, not less exciting, focus more on the paper web forming and drying with steam and even on a paper making process without any water. All eight concepts appear to be within a realistic reach but for that reason demand the willing to rethink traditionally views on papermaking and the strong desire for change.
